Andrew Wilson, chairman of UKCPT commented: "I am fortunate to be taking the chair at a company which has a good long term track record and remains full of potential, particularly as we continue to invest in and rebalance our portfolio. I look forward to continuing our strong working relationship with Standard Life Investments and, on behalf of both the Board and the management team, I would like to thank Chris for his leadership and wise counsel over the past 10 years."
